WHY BUDAPEST?

Budapest is cited as one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, with its extensive World Heritage Sites including the banks of the Danube, the Buda Castle Quarter, Andrassy Avenue, Heroes' Square and the Millennium Underground Railway, which is the second oldest in the world.

Other highlights include a total of 80 geothermal springs, the world's largest thermal water cave system, and the third largest Parliament building. The city attracts about 4.3 million tourists a year, making it the sixth most popular city in Europe according to Euromonitor. This beautiful historical capital is situated on the banks of the Danube and is called the pearl of the Danube. The city actually consists of three cities: Óbuda with Celtic and Roman ruins, Buda in the hills on the Western bank, famous for its historic Castle Hill and beautiful residential area, and Pest with its shopping, government and commercial districts on the flat plain of the Eastern bank.

The architectural beauty with monuments ranging from neoclassic, baroque to eclectic art nouveau is prevalent in the city. Budapest is also world famous for its abundance of concerts, operas, recitals, galas and exhibitions. You can find all cuisines in Hungary. There are a lot of Chinese, Turkish, Iranian, Greek, Italian, Indian and Japanese restaurants and buffets as well as fast food chains in Budapest. Certainly, as all European cities, Budapest has many cafés and teahouses, ranging from classical to modern ones, as well as art cafés.

A new type of entertainment centres of social life for young people studying in Budapest are the 'ruin pubs', which are unique in the world. They have developed along the trends of European art. They are centres for open-mindedness to other cultures and networking, where you can meet friendly and helpful people.





WHY WBS?

- » Our school building is located in the heart of the capital city, only a 5-minute walk from the Corvin Shopping Mall and 4 Metro stops from Deak Square. There are plenty of international IT companies (IBM, Nokia, EPAM, etc.), shops, cafés and apartments to rent next to our college.

In line with the demands of the world economy, Business Informatics covers several disciplines, such as the basics of Economics, Finance and Management, IT and cognitive theories. The initial training cycle brings together these seemingly independent disciplines and provides a mutually supportive transition between the areas concerned.

Special emphasis is placed on the various fields of information management, such as procedure and system development, knowledge and project management, risk and performance management as well as on IT audit and safety. Graduate students will be prepared to continue their studies on a Master level programme.

This comprehensive training has been meticulously designed based on thorough labour market research, catering for the needs of students aiming to embark on a new career path, either by combining their existing qualifications with newly acquired IT competences, or by transitioning to an entirely new field as programming-focused IT specialists.

ADMISSION PROCESS

IN 10 EASY STEPS

1. Fill in the **Registration form** on the school's website: <https://wsuf.hu/en/registration-form>
2. Pay the **application fee: 200 EUR** – non-refundable
3. Fill in the school **Application form** and upload all required documents, and complete your entrance examination if necessary.
4. Pay the **registration fee of 800 EUR** to receive your **Conditional Acceptance Letter**; the registration fee contains the fee of the Legal Assistance and is partly refundable.
5. Fill in the **Visa application form** for a student visa and upload all required documents in the school's system.
6. Follow the instructions provided through the **Legal Assistance**.
7. Pay the **administration and the tuition fees for the first 2 semesters** to receive your **Final Acceptance Letter**.
8. Make an appointment for your visa-interview at the nearest Hungarian Embassy; use the online visa booking system and inform the school of the date.
9. Present all your original documents to the Hungarian consul at the visa interview and tell him/her about your study plans in a convincing way.
10. Wait for your visa-decision, and inform the school about your visa and flight details.

Budapest Public Transport (BKK): Budapest has a well-developed transportation network. Buses, trams, trolley buses, four underground lines and exceptionally popular ships are also part of the network. Tickets and weekly or monthly passes for public transport in Budapest can be purchased at underground stations, and at ticket vending machines.

Accommodation: In the long term, it is advised to rent a flat in Budapest with friends. We help our students with their search for accommodation, so that they can find the most appropriate and comfortable place to live.

Telephone: International telephone prefix for Hungary is 36, area code for Budapest is 1. To call a number within Hungary, first dial 06, followed by the area code and the telephone number. Budapest telephone numbers have seven digits, all other areas have six digits (excluding the area code in both cases). To make an international call from Hungary, first dial +, then the country code followed by the area code and the subscriber's telephone number. To call a (Hungarian) cell phone, first dial 06, followed by the subscriber's nine-digit number (starting with either 20-, 30- or 70-, depending on which of the 3 mobile providers have issued the number).
